4:00-6:05pm: Collegiate Division final round in the Chapel

6:30pm: Awards ceremony for the Junior & Collegiate Divisions in the Chapel – reception to follow

PARKING: As you enter the Concordia campus please follow directions to Building B. Before you park you will pass through a guard gate. Please note the following information:

- **Passes/Cost** – Parking passes are not needed on Saturday, March 25th. Parking is free on campus.
- **Lot Locations** - You may park in Lot B and in Main Parking Lot C.
- **Restrictions** – Parking is not allowed in Lot A or in the purple Concordia staff lots. If you park in these lots you will be ticketed and/or towed.

ATTENDING THE PERFORMANCES

- Semi-final and final rounds on Saturday, March 25th are open to the general public. Admission is free.
- A semi-final round and final round will take place for the both Junior Division and Collegiate Division. All competing ensembles will perform two contrasting selections during each round.
- Before you enter a performance space please remember to turn off cell phone.

- No one will be admitted to the performance hall once a performance has begun; you may enter between pieces.
- No photography will be allowed within the Black Box Theater or Chapel during the semi-final or final rounds.
- Audiences are encouraged to clap at the conclusion of a performance (after the second selection).
- Audience attire is business casual for all competition rounds.
- Families are welcome and encouraged to attend the competition; however, in fairness to the competitors and judges, we do ask that children sit quietly throughout each performance.
